CCM Special Event: Angela Greenig Three Days of Prophetic Evangelism

Angela Greenig is founder of SetFree Ministries International. For the past 24 years, Angela and her husband Larry have been in ministry, preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ here at home and around the world.

As well as being the author of three books on spiritual warfare, she is best known stateside as a relevant prophetic voice, ministering with such people as Heidi Baker in her conferences and Patricia King on Extreme Prophetic TV.

For the past 18 years the Greenigs have had an effective ministry among the homeless in the inner city of Seattle, WA. During this time they have trained and released numerous men and women into prophetic evangelism. Children's ministries are also a big part of SFMI, including a Kids Club in Auburn, WA, as well as in other states and nations.

Angela, along with Bishop Yaqub Paul Masih, has done crusades and started hundreds of bible colleges and thousands of churches in Pakistan. She has also worked with Bishop Mamwee in the nation of Zambia, building an orphanage, Life Line Zambia, and a Bible College that was

planted last year.

Angela believes that God is raising up end time apostolic prophetic warriors that are on their knees in prayer and will take the world for Jesus Christ. She also believes that her greatest accomplishment is that the Lord has allowed her to raise up "Champions" for the poor in spirit, the widows, and the orphans.

Angela has a saying "to the whole world you may be one person, but to that one person you just might be the whole wide world".

It was a divine appointment that brought Angela and Pastor Sawyer together a year ago. She recognized the apostolic call and anointing on CCM. Since then, God has laid CCM on Angela's heart and she has become an intercessor, doing spiritual warfare on our behalf. Angela has called Pastor Sawyer on several

occasions—and at a crucial time had a relevant prophetic word.

Angela's time is in great demand as a minister and prophetess. However, the Lord has put CareCenter Ministries on her heart, and out of obedience to His prompting, she is coming to release the prophetic insight the Lord has given her for our region. Changing Lives at The Basket

This January, with one day left to go, we have already given food to 802 families, double the number helped in January of 2008. This month alone God has given us 101 new families.

As the economy goes down and more families are in need, He has increased the amount of food we are getting from the food bank. Those of us who have been at The Basket for awhile know that something supernaturally changed a few months back. We were running out of food and having to close early, not even being able to open on some days. It broke our hearts and as we cried out to the Lord in prayer, we started to have just enough food to meet the needs, and then we started having food left over. Now the shelves seem to stay full. The more we give the more we get. The worse the economy gets, the more God blesses us with food to give.

The most remarkable things that happen at The

Basket have little to do with groceries. A week ago a young woman, who had come to us for help, came in to tell us that God had provided

her with a car that one of our volunteers from Sojourn Church had prayed with her about. She had also been diagnosed with breast cancer and was walking in fear. But as we prayed with her, her fear was replaced with trust. We are believing God with her for her complete healing.

A high school girl, doing community service here at The Basket, told us she did not have a Bible. After giving her a New Testament she returned two hours later. She was ministered to by the staff and Pastor Sawyer and then prayed with us to receive the Lord as Saviour. She stayed that night and worshipped with us in the Solemn



Assembly, then returned Sunday morning for the worship service, her eyes sparkling with the presence of God.

A Hispanic woman, who spoke almost no English, came in for food, but was visibly upset. Weeping, she told our translator that her husband was having an affair and her marriage was ending. We prayed with her to turn her life and

circumstances over to God. The very next week she and her husband found a Hispanic church, are now both saved and have been baptized. She comes in often to share with everyone in hearing distance, speaking in both Spanish and in English, giving us testimony of God's goodness.

What are you doing from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday of every week? We are experiencing God's longsuffering towards us all, and learning, in the words of the young girl, who came for community service, and found salvation, "Not to worry about nothing, keep thinking on Jesus, and He will take care of me".
