The theme of last month's Solemn Assembly was Untapping the Creative Nature of God. Following are some of the results of those meetings:

In a prayer line on the first night, Pastor Larry was laying on hands for the prayer anointing, while Pastor Sawyer was laying on hands for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. **Miguel Zuniga**, a 54-year old resident of the RACE Program who has suffered from Diabetes for several years, was determined to fast and it was affecting his blood sugar. He was getting sleepy, nodding off, but still kept fasting.

In the midst of the prayer line, even though there had been no prayer for healing, he felt something happen. First his neck popped where he has a ruptured disc. He found he could move his neck and there was no pain. Then he noticed he wasn't tired any more. He stopped taking his insulin and reports that he is still feeling like a young man.

He finished the fast, is still working and feeling great. His blood sugar was tested and though it was high, he still has no symptoms. Leadership has made him take his insulin, but he feels no change in his body. Miguel says he knows he is healed no matter what the test says and feels better than he has felt in years.

On the same night, **Brandon Crawford**, a 24 year old Race Program resident, a Southern Baptist, had this experience:

"We were singing praises and seeking God. People looked as if they were receiving revelations left and right, but I hadn't had that "aha!" moment yet. Pastor Sawyer said we were going to line up and he and Pastor Lea were going to lay hands on us. Now, I thought, this is where I get my big revelation. We lined up and one by one we passed by the two of them. When it came my turn I was ready. Pastor Lea laid hands on me and prayed a few words...and nothing happened. I moved to Pastor Sawyer. He too laid hands on me and began praying. I wasn't feeling anything yet, but I had noticed my lips were quivering. I went to step away and Pastor Sawyer held me back and said 'Turn around son. I believe

the Lord wants to baptize you in the Holy Spirit.'

"I thought 'Oh no,' I had seen this before but never thought it would happen to me. Pastor began praying over me and told me to just let it happen. All of a sudden I opened my mouth and out came words I had never heard before. I couldn't even hear them in my own head before I spoke them. They just came out.

As I prayed at the altar, Jesus revealed to me His amazing love, not only for me, but for everyone on Earth. I will never forget the night I was baptized in the Holy Spirit."

On May 23, the day following the close of Solemn Assembly, ACTS Ministry teams were praying in preparation for Sidewalk Sunday School, **Debra Nizza**, one of the team volunteers, asked the Lord to show her what He needed from her.

"Just like that," said Debra, "a woman's face appeared so clearly. The brown eyes filled with tears—I kept blinking my eyes because I couldn't believe I was awake and seeing her face like that. God clearly said, 'You should realize she won't come to you for help. She's too afraid to say what is wrong.' That's all He said."

At the first complex they visited, Debra saw a young woman on the outer perimeter of the crowd whose face matched the one God had showed her. This encounter led to a time of deep prayer ministry for the young woman, who was going through a time of great personal difficulty. God showed His love to this woman in crisis; not only by guiding Debra to her with a vision, but also by sending another woman from CCM who was facing the same situation and was moved to pray on her behalf.
